Sheepie Bookara rooftop tent setup guide

Congratulations on your purchase of the Sheepie Bookara rooftop tent! This guide will provide step-by-step instructions to help you set up your tent and make the most of your outdoor adventures. Before you begin, ensure you have all the necessary components and follow safety precautions for a smooth setup process.

Safety Precautions:

- 1. Always set up the Sheepie Bookara rooftop tent on a level and stable surface.
- 2. Avoid areas with overhanging branches or sharp objects that could damage the tent.
- 3. Check the weather conditions before setup. Avoid setting up the tent during strong winds or storms.

Package Contents:

The Sheepie Bookara rooftop tent package should include the following:

- 1. Rooftop tent body with attached base
- 2. Mounting brackets and hardware (as shown on page 5)
- 3. Separate ladder
- 4. Attachable load bars

- 3. Cross bars or roof rack

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
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




An easy installation

Note: The following instructions assume that you have already installed the appropriate roof rack or crossbars in the load bearing position on your vehicle.

Step 1: Lift up

Lift the tent onto the rack from the side of your vehicle (2 persons). Adjust the tent to be in the centre of the roof, ensuring the rear door can be opened/closed.

Step 2: Slide bolts (shown in p.1)


Slide the T-shape bolts into the rails from both sides.


Step 3: Positioning (4x) (shown in p.2)

- 1. Slide the T shape bolts into the middle hole of the rail
- 2. Place the U shape stator, m8 flat washer, m8 washer and plastic Nut
- 3. Screw lightly in advance
- 4. Screw the other side of U shape stator (repeat step 3.2)

Step 4: Fasten (shown in p.3)

- 1. Make sure the tent is centered on your vehicle's roof and properly aligned with the mounting brackets.
- 2. Firmly tighten the bolts on each stator.
- 3. Once the tent is mounted, check its stability. Gently shake the tent to ensure it is securely attached to the roof rack.

A fast and easy set up

Step 1: Choose a Suitable Location

Choose a safe and level surface to park your vehicle before setting up the tent. Ensure there is enough space around the vehicle to extend the ladder and open the tent without obstructions.


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Step 2: Opening the hardshell cover

1. Release the four latches located at the sides and front of the rooftop tent. (shown in p.1.).

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- 2. Gently push the top part of the cover upwards (shown in p.2.).
- 3. The gas spring system will open the cover fully




Note: The tent model in the manual may differ from the image.

Step 4: Setting up the canopy

- 1. Unfold the shoe bags on the left and right sides.
- 2. Pull the telescopic pole towards the front of the tent base.
- 3. Press the pins located on the bottom left and right of the telescopic pole. (shown in p.5.).
- 4. Fully extend the telescopic pole.
- 5. Unzip the ceiling of the canopy to access the extendable rod. (shown in p.6.).
- 6. Extend the rod in the top center to firmly tension the canopy.
- 7. Zip the ceiling of the canopy back up



Step 5: Final Checks

- 1. Double-check all connections to ensure they are properly fastened and secured.
- 2. Confirm that the ladder is stable and firmly placed on the ground.



Step 3: Setting up the ladder

- 1. Extend and adjust the telescopic ladder to the right height. (shown in p.3.).
- 2. Hook the ladder to the two rings located underneath the entrance. (For earlier Bookara models, hook the ladder onto the base of the frame underneath the entrance).
- 3. Make sure each rung of the ladder is locked in place. (shown in p.4.).


Securely folding down your rooftop tent

Step 1: Preperations

- 1. Close all windows.
- 2. Unzip the ceiling of the canopy to access the extendable rod. (shown in p.1.).


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
- 3. Loosen the extendable rod in the top center of the tent.
- 4. Zip up the entrance to a two-thirds position or less. (Do not close the entrance completely when folding down the rooftop tent).



Step 2: Folding the rooftop tent

- 1. Press the pins located on the bottom left and right of the telescopic frame pole. (shown in p.2.).
- 2. Shorten the telescopic pole.
- 3. Fold down the canopy.
- 4. Tuck the shoe bags in. (shown in p.3.).





Note:

Ensure that the rooftop tent is always dry when folded. If the tent is folded while wet, it must be reopened within 24 hours for drying.



Step 3: Securing the tent

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- 1. Grab the top part of the hardshell cover and pull it down to close it. (shown in p.4.).
- 2. Check if there is no tent fabric sticking out.
- 3. Remove and shorten the telescopic ladder. (shown in p.5.).
- 4. Fasten all the latches around the cover. (shown in p.6.).
- 5. Double-check all connections to ensure they are properly fastened and secured.
- 6. Confirm that the rooftop tent is stable.





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Safety

Important information for your own safety

The fabric of this tent is not fireproof. The material can catch fire when it directly comes in contact with flames.

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Do NOT use matches, candles or open flames in or near your rooftop tent under any circumstances.

Also, you should NOT:

Cook inside the tent; make a campfire near your rooftop tent; smoke inside the tent; use fuel-powered heaters, stoves or lanterns in your rooftop tent; store inflammable liquids inside the tent.

Weight Limit: Do not use the tent with more persons than it is intended for. Overloading the tent can comprimise its structural integrity, leading to accidents or damage. For the Sheepie Bookara rooftop tent, the maximum amount of persons per model is: 2 persons for the Bookara Medium, and 2 persons for the Bookara Large.

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Securing the Ladder: Place the ladder firmly on the ground at an angle of about 70 degrees. Ensure that the ladder is securely attached to the tent and the ground. Double-check the ladder locking mechanisms before climbing up or down.

Caution with Children: Do not allow unsupervised children to play around or in the rooftop tent. Climbing the ladder or moving inside the tent without proper supervision can be hazardous.



Proper Use of Zippers: Use the tent's zippers carefully to prevent jamming or damage. Avoid forcing the zippers and make sure they are free from debris or obstructions.

Traveling with the Tent: Be cautious of overhead obstacles and clearance heights while traveling with the rooftop tent on your vehicle. Avoid low-clearance areas and obstacles. Stay safe on the road and be vigilant about overhead clearance.


1. Inspect the Tent Regularly:

To ensure the Sheepie rooftop tent is in good condition and safe to use, inspect it regularly. Check for signs of wear, tear, or any damage to the fabric, zippers, poles, and straps. If you find any issues, do not use the tent until they are repaired or replaced.

2. Proper Installation:

Always follow the manufacturer's guidelines for installing the tent on your vehicle. Incorrect installation may lead to accidents or death. Make sure all straps, buckles, and mounts are securely fastened and tightened.

We strongly advise keeping the distance between your car load bars (front to rear bar) between 70-110cm and to make sure that the rooftop tent is centred as much as possible.



We advise making sure that your rooftop tent does not extend more than 60 cm from the front crossbar. A minimum of 80cm (size B) of clearance is required for installation of the rooftop tent. You should always check if both load bars reach this size (for most vehicles it does). Sheepie offers optional adapter kits in case your vehicle does not reach this size. For installations on roof racks, often used on 4WD vehicles, consult your Sheepie dealer.



3. Weight Limit:

Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of your vehicle and your crossbars/ roof rack. Always follow the instructions provided by the manufacturer of your vehicle and your crossbars/roof rack.

4. Securing Your Gear:

Properly secure all your gear inside the tent while traveling to prevent items from shifting and damaging the tent fabric during transit.

5. Driving Precautions:

While driving with the Sheepie rooftop tent mounted on your vehicle, observe the following precautions:

a. Do not exceed the recommended speed limits while carrying the tent.
We recommend not to drive faster than 120km/h with a rooftop tent. Exceeding this speed can result in accidents,

damage to your vehicle and rooftop tent. b. Avoid low clearance areas or driving

- under obstacles that may hit the tent. c. Drive carefully in adverse weather conditions (high winds, heavy rain, etc.),
- as they may affect the stability of the tent. Keep in mind that your car's total height is higher with a rooftop tent and that the handling of your car can be different (sidewind sensitivity, behaviour in corners and when braking, etc.).
- d. Check every time before you drive, and regularly throughout your trip, if your rooftop tent is still securely attached to your roof racks. This also applies to your roof racks themselves.

6. Be Cautious During Setup:

When setting up the tent, be cautious of your surroundings. Avoid locations with overhanging branches, sharp rocks, or uneven surfaces that may puncture the fabric or damage the tent structure.

7. Handling Poles and Mechanisms:

Be gentle when extending or collapsing the tent poles and mechanisms. Rough handling can cause them to bend or break, leading to potential accidents and damage to the tent.
